

Saito is an ancient daimyo family originally coming from Echizen. The clan's home province is Mino, worth 5 points of rice tax.

Recent History

Born in Kyoto, the current clan Lord was at first a priest, but returned to the secular world, becoming an oil merchant for a while.

He joined the service of Nagai Nagahiro and was eventually adopted by the Nishimura samurai family and took on the name of Hidemoto. He killed Nagahiro and changed his name to Nagai Toshimasa. He then expelled Toki Yoshiyori, the then governor of Mino province and adopted the name of Saito and made war against the late Oda Nobuhide of Owari.

Fearing defeat Toshimasa made peace with the Oda Clan and gave his daughter in marriage to Oda Nobunaga.

SAITO TOSHIMASA (57) Lord of Mino and leader of the Saito clan.

AKECHI MITSUHIDE (25) Loyal vassal to the Saito clan & Clan General.


SAITO YOSHITATSU (24) Son of Toki Yoshiyori, and adopted by Saito Toshimasa as his clan heir.

Toshimasa's daughter has recently married Oda Nobunaga, the young lord of Owari province.




You hope to either use Nobunaga to further build your power, or, gain greater status by backing Oda in his actions, should he decide to expand.

You feel that the commoners are getting rich on these wars, and that you should join in on this general atmosphere of wealth creation. Your personal objectives are therefore:


- a. To ensure that you clan becomes and remains very wealthy.

Your personal objectives are therefore:


- a. To ensure that the clan survives at all costs.

Your personal objectives are therefore:


- a. To ensure that your clan becomes famed for its lavish patronage of the arts, if not the most famous clan in the land.
